PE days

For woodlands sessions particularly during the winter, children need to bring a spare pair of clothes, welly boots and/or wet weather gear.

Please name all items of clothing to avoid any mix ups and items going missing. Any earrings will need to be removed on these days or covered with tape. Please also ensure hair is tied back.

Routines

Please ensure that your child comes to school each day with their water bottle, reading book and reading record book in a book bag each day. Please ensure all items including all uniform are clearly named.

Due to lack of storage space, we request that children in Key Stage I do not bring backpacks. Children's book bags will be the only daily bag needed.

Children's reading books will be changed in line with the reading scheme, please check children's reading records to see more information on this.

Each week, children will visit the library and bring home a book of their choice.

Please make sure this in in their book bags on their library days to be changes.
