



How we are celebrating World Book Day 2022 (Thursday 3rd March) at Grove Primary School:

Dressing up: On Thursday 3rd March, as usual the children are invited to come into school dressed as their favourite book character OR slightly differently this year, they may wish to come dressed as a word. You could think of an interesting/unusual word and come dressed as that. You could recycle/use items you already have at home to create a costume. Your child would need to wear a sign or label so everyone can read what they are dressed as. If you Google 'Vocabulary Parade' you will see lots of great ideas to spark your imagination and it hopefully won't cost a thing to create.

Book Swap: On Thursday 3rd March, we would like to invite all children to bring in a pre-loved/outgrown (*but still in good condition*) book from home, which they would be happy to swap at school. This will mean that every child will go home with a new, exciting book to read and enjoy at home!
