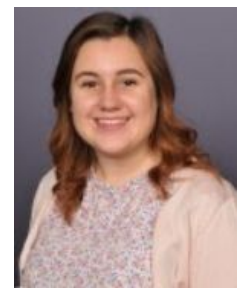
Mrs Lark

What we are learning

PE & Woodland

Children will be taking part in one woodland and one outdoor PE session this half term. Please ensure kits are in school all week so that your child can fully participate. After half term, children will have one outdoor and one indoor PE session, no woodlands, until Spring 2 term.

A reminder that PE kits should contain: a white t shirt, black shorts, black/grey jogging bottoms, plimsolls and/or trainers. For woodlands sessions, particularly during the winter, children need to bring a spare pair of clothes, welly boots and/or wet weather gear.

Any earrings will need to be removed on these days or covered with tape (from home).



Routines

Please ensure that your child comes to school each day with their water bottle, reading book and reading record book in a book bag.

Please ensure all items, including all uniform are clearly named.

Children's reading books will be changed in line with where they are in on the reading scheme, please check children's reading records to see more information on this.

Each week, children will visit the library and bring home book of their choice. Please make sure this in their book bags on their library days to be changed. (See reading record book for timetable)
