#### What we are learning

During this half term we will be learning ...

- as geographers, we will be taking a road trip across America travelling across both the North and South.
- as writers, we will be writing our own poems and narrative linked with the Americas.

- as mathematicians, we will be revisiting our learning on place value and using our knowledge to answer problem solving and reasoning questions.
