Welcome to Key Stage 1



During this half term we will be learning all about Our family history. We will be learning

- **as historians** to find similarities between the past and present.
- **as writers** we will be writing a short time travelling story as well as recounting an event from the past.
- as scientists we will explore the structure of a variety of animals including humans and identifying their classification groups.
- as mathematicians to explore numbers in a variety of different ways.
- as design technologists to experiment with a variety of pattern, line and shape to create drawing.
- as a religious expert to explore how Christians look after the world.
- **as athletes** to develop our co-ordination through catching and throwing.

Homework

Research has shown that giving children ownership of their homework and allowing learning to take place through creative ways produces more memorable and higher quality outcomes. Therefore homework in Key Stage 1 this year will be set through a homework menu. Children will be required to pick one task a week to complete as part of their weekly homework, alongside their daily reading and practice of their every day words.
