<u>What we are learning</u>



As geographers we will be investigating the sustainability of the chocolate trade. We are going to be developing our map skills and exploring human geography including trade links and economic activity.

As scientists we will be exploring how light travels in straight lines and we will conduct research into how shadows are cast.

As writers we will be taking inspiration from the wordless graphic novel 'The Arrival' to write our own narratives. We will also be creating news broadcasts later on in the term.

As readers we will be reading, enjoying and discussing our novels in our whole class reading sessions. We will also be reading non-fiction, songs and poetry.

As mathematicians we will be developing our understanding of place value, the four calculations and fractions over the Autumn Term.

As artists we will be creating work inspired by Gustav Klimt. The unit will involve creating an artist study to identify Klimt's art style which will lead to us creating collages inspired by his work.

As musicians we will be creating a mini musical performance about the effects of the slave trade in a West African village.

Computing – our unit is based on creating and using spreadsheets and learning how we can use formulas to calculate the cost of events.

PSHE – Our sessions are all about 'Being my Best'. We will explore the 5 ways to well-being.

PE – This term, we will be learning how to play Hockey. We will be revising and developing our defending skills whilst working together and communicating as a team.

Religion and Worldviews - In these sessions we will be exploring how religion brings peace to conflicts. We will be looking closely at the religions of Christianity and Islam.

Woodlands – this term we will be creating environmental art inspired by Andy Goldsworthy and will be creating natural collages.

- Children will be set a spelling activity on Edshed each week which will link to the spellings they are being taught in class that week.
- Children will be asked to read daily (10 minutes each night) that will help towards the school reading challenge. Please make sure that children bring their books in every day
- Children will be asked to log in to Times Table Rock Stars every week and practise their times tables for at least 20 minutes over the week
- Children will get a homework menu to choose an activity linked to our curriculum too which you can choose each week.

PE days



Children will be taking part in one woodland and one outdoor PE session this half term. Please ensure PE kits are in school at the **beginning of each week** so that your child can fully participate. A reminder that PE kits should contain: a white t shirt, black shorts, black/grey jogging bottoms, plimsolls and/or trainers. For woodlands sessions particularly during the winter children need to bring a spare pair of clothes, welly boots or wet weather gear. Please name all items of clothing to avoid any mix ups and items going missing. Any earrings will need to be removed on these day.
